Supply list for From Figure to Face - with a single brush

Canvases - Two 30 x 40" stretched canvases, painted black using black acrylic gesso or Golden Mars Black acrylic paint.

Pencil - A white Aquarelle or Lumocolor pencil to do the drawing.

Paints - Two-ounce tubes of Golden acrylic in these colours only: Titanium White, Cadmium Red LIGHT, Cadmium Red DARK, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Phthalo Blue (green shade). Please bring Golden paints only.

Make sure they are the traditional acrylic paint and NOT the slow drying Golden Open brand.

Brush - The only brush we will use is a Corona "Sabre" 1 1/2 inch brush. I will have brushes available for sale at the class if you aren't able to find one. The price is \$16 (includes tax).

Palette - I have found the best palette for acrylics is a large Tupperware/ Rubbermaid type container about 8 inches by 12 inches by 2 inches. I put the paint on the inside of the lid and invert the bottom to seal when not in use. The paint stays wet for days.

Bucket and cloth rags - For water and for wiping your brush.

Image - Either digital image (preferred) or large-scale printed photo of someone close to you - a family member, a friend, or a photo of yourself. This will be the reference for your second painting.
