

## **Drawing Imaginative Realism**

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### **Supply List**

Any pencils that you already have. Graphite, charcoal, blacklead (Pitt Matt Graphite), white charcoal (chalk) pencils. A variety is useful.

A pure graphite stick and a pure charcoal stick. (not in wood pencil form).

A sharpener with two hole sizes.

Erasers, art gum (brown) for larger areas. Pink pearl, white vinyl or kneadable also work. Smaller mechanical pencil style vinyl erasers come in handy for small areas.

Basic white paper for sketching, can be off-white newsprint or sketchbook at least 11"x14", large is recommended (up to 18"x24" maximum). Many sheets.

Toned paper, Strathmore Toned Tan, Strathmore Toned Grey or Canson Mi-Tientes Oyster is optimal, however, any cardboard coloured parcel paper can also work. The grey-scale value of the paper must be dark enough to show white pencil (newsprint is too light). At least four sheets.

A ruler that is at least 12 inches (30cm) long.

Blending stumps. Sometimes called tortillons. A least two sizes (large and small).
